Educational Purpose

The purpose of the Chromebook 1:1 Program is to provide equipment and resources that meet the needs of today's students and help them to become future ready. Having a tool, such as a chromebook, can open up many exciting creative educational opportunities.

The chromebook program helps facilitate:

- Access to digital educational resources including resources and ebooks paid for by our West Side library program (checkout our library resources webpage)
- Availability of resources beyond the school day and outside the school building
- Individualized learning
- Creativity and Innovation
- Critical thinking and problem solving
- Communication and collaboration
- Technology literacy skills including Internet Safety and Security

Expectations

- It is the student's responsibility to charge their computers at home each night and bring their devices fully charged each morning. Students should consider the charging of their chromebook to be a nightly "homework" assignment. Teachers will be designing many of their lessons and classroom activities based on students having access to their chromebook. <u>Chromebooks should be brought to school fully charged everyday!</u>
- Chromebooks should be carried to and from school in the carrying case provided.
- The chromebook is school property and should be used and treated responsibly. Students are to only access content and websites as directed by their teachers.
- Chromebook use, in and out of school, will follow the Elkhorn Area School District's <u>Acceptable Technology Use Agreement</u>
- If the chromebook is in need of repair, please have your child turn it into the library. They will receive a Chromebook to use during the school day until their device can be fixed by the Technology Department Staff.
